



## Typical Costs for Tongue and Lip Tie Treatment

Most parents do not carry dental insurance coverage for their infants. However, if your child does have dental insurance coverage, a tongue or lip tie revision is a typically covered procedure. The coverage ranges between 50% - 80% depending on the type of dental plan you have. Drs. Schumacher and Bauer are happy to submit to dental insurance to try to get the maximum coverage for you, however, the patient is responsible for any cost that the insurance company does not cover. If you would like to know your exact coverage prior to your appointment, contact our financial coordinators with your dental insurance information and we will research that for you. Our fees are:

D7960 – Frenectomy Lip: \$552.00

D7960 – Frenectomy Tongue: \$552.00

Drs. Schumacher and Bauer are not direct providers for any medical insurance coverage. This procedure is not typically covered under medical insurance; however, it is based on the type of plan that you have. If you think that your medical insurance will cover this procedure, and would like to seek reimbursement from them, we are happy to provide any necessary documentation you may need to submit a claim. However, we will not submit directly to your medical insurance company on your behalf and you are responsible for payment on the day of service.
